Class Yipeeee! Activity:

1) Group of 3. INTRODUCE in Sanskrit:

- Each **greet** each other: **namo...**
- Start left to right:** What is your name sir/madam please? Are you well sir/madam? Thank you.

2) SOLVE BELOW: Ensure everyone **contributes equally**. Only progress when **all 3 are satisfied** with translation.

- You **ask**, she **asks**, and I **ask**.
 - I **go** to the **television**.
 - I **go**, you **go**, and she **asks** the **book**.
 - Flower**, **water** and **milk** please!
 - I **go** to the **book** and **window**.
 - You **ask** the **garment**, and he **goes** to the **fruit**.
 - You **go** to the **spectacles**, and I **ask** the **leaf**.
 - parṇam upanetram ca.**
 - vastram jalam ca.**
 - phalam puṣpam ca.**
- k. Partner 1 & 2 agree on a word to insert. Partner 3 translates. Repeat until all gotten chance.
- She **asks** the **INSERT_NOUN**.
 - I **go** to **INSERT_NOUN**.
 - gacchasi INSERT_VERB ca.**
 - pr̥cchati INSERT_VERB ca.**
